Cabling

Please do not arrange for cabling directly to the INX; rather work through the INX Ops team. In all cases, the INX Ops team will have to send you a Letter of Authorisation (LOA) to grant access to cabling entering the JINX cabinets.

Physical locations

Physical access to the JINX locations is restricted to the INX OPS team. Should there be a reasonable need for access to the site, please contact the ops team for an access permit.

IP address allocation

The IPv4/IPv6 address blocks for JINX are:

- DATA vlan: 196.223.14.X/24 and 2001:43f8:1f0::X/64
- VOIP vlan: 196.223.15.X/24 and 2001:43f8:1f0:1::X/64

where X is assigned on application for a port.

The addresses in use for the peering networks have AS0 RPKI ROAs, and should not be visible on the Internet.
